
Remote Curriculum – The Literary Canon

Year 7 The House With Chicken Legs...




Marinka dreams of a normal life, where her house stays in one place long enough for her to make friends. But her house has chicken legs and moves on without warning.

Year 8




Nobody Owens, is a normal boy. He would be completely normal if he didn't live in a graveyard, raised and educated by ghosts.

Year 9




When Comity's mother gets bitten by a snake, she turn to Fred, the Aboriginal yard boy, who becomes her only friend.


The Remains of the Day...


The Day I was Erased...


Nowhere to Run...


