**Re: Year 9 Options Evening**

We are looking forward to welcoming you to the College on Thursday, 12 December for the launch of our Year 9 Options process. The evening runs from 5.00 to 7.00pm and you can arrive at any point during the evening.

Students will be provided with their Options Guide pack on the evening.
