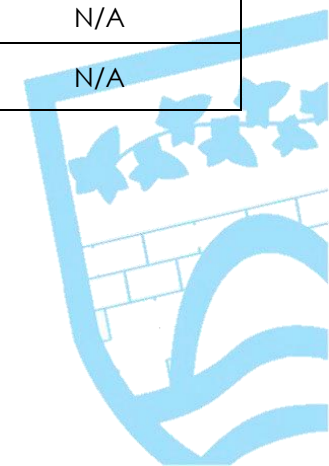

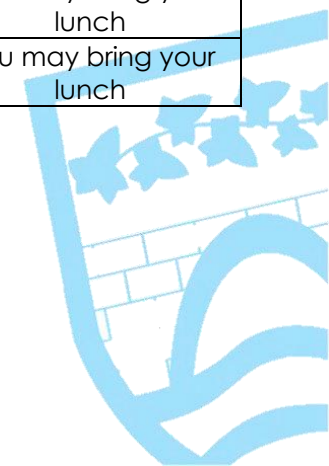

Our vision is to give every child, from Primary right through to Sixth Form, the opportunity to develop their athletic ability, improve their skills and reach their full performance potential. Whether they are joining for grassroots participation or competing at a performance level, we are committed to supporting their journey. We achieve this by providing access to excellent teaching, expert coaching and specialist sports provision, all carefully balanced alongside their academic commitments.

Our Academy Pathways

The Sports Academy comprises the Football Academy, the Gymnastics Academy, and the Rugby Academy. Each provides a clear, structured pathway from Primary School through to our Development and Performance levels.

Please note, a recent update to our terminology: the highest-level athletes within each discipline will now be officially recognised as the Performance Football Squad, Performance Gymnastics Squad, and Performance Rugby Squad.

Our Development Squads are open to all students at Ivybridge Community College. The core purpose of these squads is to encourage active participation, with a strong focus on improving physical fitness, having fun and building social connections. Students who participate in the Development Squads will also have the opportunity to progress and be selected for the Performance Squads. Furthermore, they will have the chance to represent the College in central venue fixtures and festivals as part of the Plymouth Schools Sports Partnership, which coordinates a fantastic range of inter-school sports leagues, festivals and School Games tournaments throughout the year.

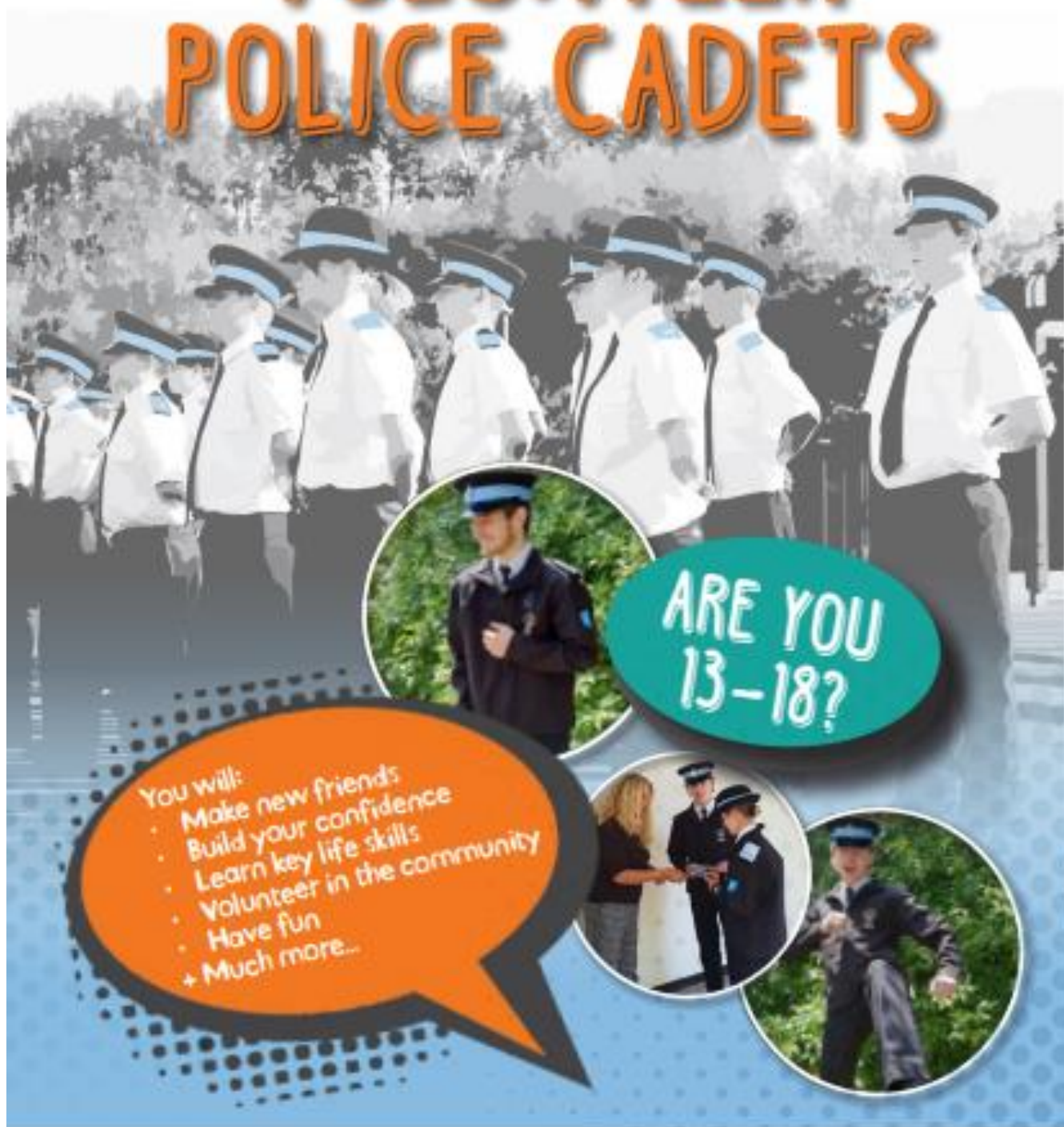
