### Overview

This is a fantastic opportunity to spend 4 days/3 nights in the fabulous Spanish city of Barcelona with coach to Bristol airport and flights to Barcelona. We will be staying in a central Youth Hostel with breakfast and dinner included.

We will visit the world famous sites of Sagrada Familia Cathedral, Parc Guell, Poble Espanyol (traditional Spanish village), Barcelona market, Barcelona FC's Nou Camp and also experience a flamenco evening AND a day trip to PortAventura theme park.

We will be leaving Ivybridge Community College Coach Park on Monday, 29 June and will return on Thursday, 2 July late in the evening. The students will be travelling by coach to Bristol Airport before continuing to the Urbany Hostel which is situated in central Barcelona.

The cost of the trip is £600. Students will need to bring with them money for lunches on each of the 4 days and any money that they would like for souvenirs.

Please be aware that the students will need an **individual passport** which is your responsibility to obtain; we no longer provide group passports. This must be valid until at least the end of January 2021 (six months after we return). They will also need a **European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)** which can be obtained online and is free. Please note that this is all subject to change depending on Brexit.

The students will be allowed to wear their own clothes throughout the trip. We expect the weather to be warm but students should pack a warm jumper and a waterproof just in case. They will also be required to carry an Emergency Contact Card with them at all times (provided by the College) which will contain the details of where they are staying (written in Spanish), and teaching staff details.

The trip is an excellent opportunity for students to experience Spanish culture but IS NOT ONLY FOR STUDENTS OF SPANISH.

# Overview

### Travel

We will be travelling by coach to Bristol airport and then again by coach to our youth hostel in Barcelona. There will be some use of public transport in Barcelona though many sites are in walking distance of the youth hostel. Our coach will transport us to PortAventura Theme Park.

# Accommodation

We will be staying in Urbany Hostel situated in central Barcelona. It offers a high standard of group accommodation in 4 – 8 bedded rooms and all have ensuite facilities. The hostel is a short walk from the Sagrada Familia and central Barcelona and is a mile from the beach.


