Overview

If your child loves Science and Adventures, they will love this package!

We will meet at 8am on Monday, 29 June and leave for the Eden Project at 8.30am. We will participate in a 'Storm Patrol' workshop and a 'Climate Challenge'. We will then stay overnight at the Eden Project YHA. From there, on Tuesday morning, we will go to Adrenalin Quarry where we will have fun in the AquaPark and on The Zip ride. We will arrive back in College for students to return home via their usual method of transport at 3.15pm. Food will be provided for the Monday and Tuesday.

On the Wednesday, we will have a day in College, beginning and ending at the usual time, exploring Science through our Forensic Science and our Kitchen Science workshops. Hopefully they can use what they learned during the latter to impress you at home.

On Thursday, we will spend the day Tree-surfing at the Tamar Trails adventure centre. This will be within usual College hours. Active clothing is essential for this activity.

On Friday, we will make vehicles in College for our 'Wacky Races' day, including rocket-powered lego cars.

The cost of the trip is £160 - £170. The students will be allowed to wear their own clothes throughout the trip and will be provided with wetsuits for Adrenalin Quarry, but for the overnight stay and Aqua Park, they will need to bring wash bags, pyjamas and two changes of clothes, plus towels.

Payment Information

Booking and payment of a package must be made using ParentPay. If you have not used it before, please go to www.parentpay.com and log in to activate your account and use the user name and password sent to you by the College.

All packages have a maximum number of spaces and are offered on a 'first come first served' basis. All packages are different with regards to the number of available spaces. If a package is full, students must choose an alternative package.

Once booking is completed and deposits are paid, a student's place is automatically secured. Students' details will be extracted from SIMS for offsite trips to include parent contact details, medical information, and allergies. Please ensure you inform the College of any changes in personal details. The act of booking and paying for your child's package on ParentPay represents consent for them to participate in that chosen package.

How to Pay

1. ParentPay must be used to sign up all students for Enrichment Week
2. Select a package (subject to availability)
3. Follow the schedule of payment outlined in the overview on the College website
4. Return Slip – return the attached slip to your son/daughter's Tutor by **Monday, 13 January 2020**. By handing in the return slip you are confirming payment of your deposit, chosen package and informing the College of any personal information that has changed since September 2019. You are also confirming your agreement with all the guidelines set out in the booklet. We also need to know about swimming ability if attending water-based activities
5. All Early Sign-Up packages will go live on parentpay from **Friday, 8 November**
