Overview

The PE Department have organised a five day trip to Holland to train and be treated like a professional for selected Academy Students at the College during Enrichment Week in 2020. The tour will include two training sessions with KNVB coaches (Dutch Football Association) at the training base and two local opposition teams. There will be a tour of the AFC Ajax stadium, visit to the club shop and a 'This is Holland footballing experience'. There will also be leisure activities including a visit to the Efteling/Walibi Theme Park and Ten Pin Bowling.

We will be leaving lybridge Community College Coach Park early on Monday, 29 June and return Friday, 3 July. Exclusive use of executive coach throughout tour for the time we leave lybridge and return. Student's accommodation will be in multi bedded rooms within the hostel. Staff in twin / single rooms. Half Board meal plan in resort. The students will be travelling by coach, crossing the channel at Dover ferry port, before continuing to the resort yet TBC. The same coach will be used to transport the students throughout the duration of the trip.
