Overview

If, like me, you consider yourself a water baby we have the fantastic opportunity to embark on the first of the internationally recognised SCUBA qualifications and your licence to experience SCUBA around the world. The first 3 days will be with Aquanauts Diving Centre in Plymouth where we will develop our knowledge of SCUBA, water safety and the underwater realm through quizzes and exams (yes, you've got tests!!) This knowledge development will require a sizeable chunk of reading, research and learning BEFORE the week itself and this will be monitored by the staff at Aquanauts and Ivybridge Community College. Then we will hit the water in a controlled and safe environment – a swimming pool. Here the students will practice and become increasingly confident in skills and drills underwater and on the surface.

After the initial training, success in the pool and completion of the knowledge reviews the students will complete 2 open water dives in the sea around Plymouth. Here the students will complete the same skills practiced in the pool and enjoy pleasure dives exploring the surprising underwater life of British seas.

Success sees the students receive the PADI SCUBA Diver qualification allowing them to dive anywhere in the world under direct supervision of a PADI professional diver. The upgrade to the Jr PADI Open Water Diver qualification would see the students able to dive with another diver of similar or higher qualification above the age of 15 years old. Your Jr PADI Open Water will automatically upgrade to the full Open Water qualification on the student's 15th birthday – the qualification that keeps giving!!

We will have one day at Splashdown Waterpark in Paignton – an Ivybridge Community College favourite!! Also we have the opportunity to explore the Plymouth Sound on SUP. We will receive full tuition and equipment to experience one of the fastest growing watersports around the world – increasingly linked with wellbeing, zero carbon impact and a silent way to enjoy the waterways of the South West – apart from all of the splashing from falling off of course!

Further Considerations – with the nature of the activities each student should be considered a 'competent' swimmer and comfortable in the water. There are also medical concerns and a waiver to be completed for the SCUBA part of the week. This revolves around respiratory issues – asthma, hayfever etc and can require a letter from your Doctor in order to start the week. If you have any questions in this situation I will ask that you contact preynolds@ivybridge.devon.sch.uk as soon as you can, as any such paperwork will need to be completed 2 weeks after signing up to the Enrichment Week activities.

Travel

We will be travelling by minibus with a qualified member of Ivybridge Community College staff. The minibus stays with us throughout our activities and is available for our use.

Accommodation

This is a series of day trips only.



Insurance

Each provider has insurance that will cover all activities. Ivybridge Community College also has comprehensive insurance covering the travel to and from the different providers.

What is included in the price?

- PADI SCUBA Diver qualification this can be upgraded to the full PADI Open Water Diver qualification for an additional £50 and would be completed outside of the Enrichment Week days.
- All study materials and equipment is provided eg manuals, wetsuits, diving equipment etc.
 Students can bring their own equipment and wear it should the providers deem it appropriate for the chosen activities.
- Entrance to Splashdown Waterpark.
- Tuition and equipment required to experience SUP'ing.
