You will receive an email with a PowerPoint which explains the topic using video clips and written explanation. There is a 6 mark question for you to have a go at with a suggested format to email to Mrs Brooks. 6 Mark answers should have 2xPEAC paragraphs and an AJIM conclusion. This will be explained in the Powerpoint. You will have a week to complete this.</p>

Create a labelled diagram, ensuring you have labelled where the audience is in relation to the stage.</li> <li>3. Explain your understanding of <b>two</b> different practitioners or styles of theatre.</li> <li>4.
