Your challenge is to fill an A4 page with sketches or pictures of bedroom storage solutions and then analyse each one. This work will be used in the next design challenge to help you design your own products. <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Drama</b></p> <p><b>Task 1:</b> Posted on epraise. Thinking about one of the professional theatre productions you have watched, recreate the design elements of the production to include: A ground plan of the set, labelled to indicate key set features, important props or furniture, entrance and exit points. One character's costume drawn and labelled, noting what the costume is and how these choices contribute to the character and/or production. A comment about the lights and sound used in the production to help create and communicate meaning.</p> <p><b>Task 2:</b> Look carefully at each of the images and write down your thoughts about each one.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Fashion and Textiles</b></p> <p>Plastic fusion samples. This week students should experiment with the techniques plastic fusion. All instructions are uploaded to Microsoft Teams. Files &gt; Week 3 task. Look at examples in PowerPoint to give you inspiration before you start planning designs for your own samples. Remember our project theme is Urban Architecture. In you sketchbooks: Reference the textiles artists, with a step by step guide and your own samples.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Food and Nutrition</b></p> <p>Continue your own family recipe book! Chat to family and friends to find out their favourite dishes and meals. If you can't see them at the moment, pick up the phone or go online (if you can, with parental permission). Try to include at least 4 of your family favourites. Be creative – you can use ICT or draw out by hand!</p>
