Watch the video and complete the next SPARX compulsory tasks (deadline Wednesday, 27 May). <b>Task 3:</b> On Wednesday, 20 May you will also receive, via epraise, a retention worksheet. These videos are there to support your understanding of the tasks and texts. <b>Submission Task:</b> Submit your Character Profile with a picture of the character. (Week 3 booklet- page 6). Remember to keep completing your Bedrock lessons.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science</b></p> <p>Using the "Year 8 Heat Transfer" sheet on epraise, find out about how members of the same species differ from each other and how this helps them to survive. Hopefully you will be inspired to try some of the optional activities that are also on epraise. From Wednesday, you will also find a link to a form on epraise that will be sent to your teachers so that they can see how you are managing with your work.</p>

This will be saved in Handouts, Moodle (History, Key Stage 3) and an explanation will be put on Streams.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Geography</b></p> <p>This week in Geography, you will be completing the lesson "What are erosion landforms?". This will build on your learning in the past two weeks about the waves and their erosion processes. The first task is in the style of a Silent Starter, and is a simple knowledge retrieval task. The second task will be a question or task that asks you to apply their learning. The third task is an optional extension, intended for those who would like to complete it, or for GCSE-minded students. It is a creative task, with a variety of ways in which it can be completed.
