An abstract noun is a concept, quality, or emotional state rather than a tangible object. For example; love, jealousy, danger. List 5 abstract nouns. Write down 5 adjectives/adverbs that connect to each noun. TASK 2 - APPLY KNOWLEDGE. Physical Theatre is when you use your body as the primary way to communicate meaning, rather than words.
