<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Mathematics</b></p> <p><b>Task 1:</b> Complete your SPARX compulsory homework by Wednesday, 3 June. <b>Task 2:</b> On Wednesday, 3 June you will receive a link on epraise to a video of an Ivybridge Community College teacher covering the next topic/objective. Watch the video and complete the next SPARX compulsory tasks (deadline Wednesday, 10 June). <b>Task 3:</b> On Wednesday, 3 June you will also receive, via epraise, a retention worksheet. Using the "Year 7 Chemical Reactions" sheet on epraise, find out how chemical reactions occur and how we know when they are happening. Hopefully you will be inspired to try some of the optional activities.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>History</b></p> <p>This week please create fact files about Elizabeth I. There is also an optional stretch it activity for those who have completed the tasks. Stretch it: What was the Spanish Armada? Why did it fail? The supporting document for an optional stretch it activity can be found in Handouts, Moodle (History, Key Stage 3) and instructions will be on epraise.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Geography</b></p> <p>This week in Geography, you will be completing the lesson "What is the global issue with plastic?". This will be saved in Handouts with audio to help explain the lesson.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Modern Foreign Languages</b></p> <p>This week you will be continuing your retrieval booklets on Free Time. These can be found in Handouts along with a PowerPoint explaining which activities you need to do. Check epraise for full instructions as to how to find the booklets and links to optional activities to stretch yourself.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Religious Studies</b></p> <p>This week's work is to make sure your Spirited Arts work is completed. Then complete another 20 mins on your booklet on Sikhism. You do not need to finish it completely. If you have not found the booklet it is in Handouts and on epraise.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Drama</b></p> <p><b>Year 7 – STORYBOARDING PROJECT</b></p> <p>TASK 1 – RECAP LEARNING. An abstract noun is a concept, quality, or emotional state rather than a tangible object. For example; love, jealousy, danger. List 5 abstract nouns. Write down 5 adjectives/adverbs that connect to each noun.</p> <p>TASK 2 – APPLY KNOWLEDGE. Physical Theatre is when you use your body as the primary way to communicate meaning, rather than words. This means that the physical position of characters is most important. Also, sound is often used to make the intended meaning clearer to an audience. Your task is to create a storyboard of 6 images involving at least 3 characters, which illustrate a possible representation of one of your abstract nouns. Label each part of the storyboard to make the diagram clear, and to indicate the sound being used.</p> <p>OPTIONAL Task 3 – Get creative. Imagine your storyboard sequence is being performed on stage. Add at least 3 technical design elements to your drawings from Task 2.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PE</b></p> <p>We will now be revisiting the Different PE challenges to see if you have made improvements following all of your Physical Activity. This week the focus will be Legs, Bums and Tums. Please continue to record any other activities you are taking part in and send photos in for us to share and see. There will also be details regarding to a School Games challenge which is being set by Devon County Council, if you would like to get involved in these, details will follow. There will be a streams video which will guide to lots of different activities going on nationally and in the local community.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Design Technology/Food Tech</b></p> <p>This week's challenge is to design an insect hotel. Having an insect hotel in your garden is a great way to naturally encourage beneficial insects to visit.
