

Enrichment Activities	Times and Venue	Information	Cost
<b>Sports Day</b>	See timetable for time Meet on AW1	All students will be taking part in Sports Day during the morning or afternoon. Students are to meet on the AW1 at 9.10am or 12.10pm depending on students being in Group 1 or 2 (see timetable). Students must sit in their Tutor Group as instructed by PE Staff. Students must wear blue Ivybridge Community College PE kit and trainers. Please do not wear hoodies or other type of sportswear. Students in the Elite Squads are allowed to wear their blue academy kit. Please dress appropriately for the weather (warm and waterproof clothing or sun protection, depending on conditions). All students will stop for their normal break and lunch times. Bring plenty to drink for the day!	<b>£0</b>
<b>Options – All students to sign up to one of the below activities</b>			
<b>Option 1 Gymnastics and Free G</b>	See timetable for time <b>Meet outside the Gymnasium</b>	Students will have the opportunity to spend their time exploring different areas of gymnastics and Free G. Students will spend their time developing their gymnastic skills on springboards and trampets, vaults, air tracks and high-level Free G equipment. If students like to bounce and want to develop their gymnastic talents, then this is the workshop for them!	<b>£0</b>
<b>Option 2 Cinema</b>	See timetable for time <b>Meet outside the Performance Hall</b>	Students will have the opportunity to sit back and relax and watch a film in our very own Performance Hall. The film will be a favourite one to watch and appropriate to the age group. Students are more than welcome to bring popcorn, sweets and drinks to be fully prepared for the film. There will be an interval to collect food from the Dining Hall. Meet outside of the Performance Hall to be shown to your seats.	<b>£0</b>
<b>Option 3 Wacky Races and Rocket Cars Workshop</b>	See timetable for time <b>Meet in D1.03</b> <b>20 Places Available</b>	Students can design a fan-powered car. After we have raced those, we are going to make rocket-powered cars, which we will need to test outside. The winning team of this challenge will be the one that gets their car to travel the furthest.	<b>£0</b>
<b>Option 4 Arts and Crafts</b>	See timetable for time <b>Meet outside the LRC</b> <b>20 Places Available</b>	Students have the opportunity to make a denim book sleeve (or bag). A great way to keep your books safe in your bag, or a lovely present. This would require students to bring in an old pair of jeans (we may be able to provide some too). Students would spend the time decorating them with fun and funky designs, using fabric, ribbons, glitter etc. Students are welcome to bring in any extra embellishments they would like.	<b>£0</b>

<b>Option 5 Dance Workshop</b>	See timetable for time <b>Meet in Studio 2</b>	Students have the opportunity to dance, learn new material and create material towards a performance. The performance will be based on the musical Hamilton.	<b>£0</b>
<b>Option 6 Creative Arts Workshop</b>	See timetable for time <b>Room to be confirmed 28 Places Available</b>	Students will be signed up to one of four practical workshops. This is a must for existing Art, Photography and Textiles students as the workshops are designed to enhance current skills that will support future learning and can help gain additional coursework marks. However, anyone with an interest in creative learning will gain much from this experience. Workshops include Painting and Drawing, Screen Printing, Sculpture or Photography. Students will work in specialist classrooms and receive tailored tuition to support their experience. Mrs Reddy will confirm the room you are to meet in for this workshop once you have signed up.	<b>£0</b>
<b>Option 7 Music Workshop</b>	See timetable for time <b>Meet in C3.07 27 Places Available</b>	A Music Variety Day to include a carousel of music-making activities, such as (1) development of your performance skills as a soloist and part of an ensemble, working in bands under the specialist guidance of our highly experienced Music staff. (2) An opportunity to create and develop a free composition in any style, with unlimited access to the entire Music Department and its facilities including our professional Recording Studio. Finally, this is the day to make all Music dreams come true, whatever you want the focus to be e.g. use of the Recording Studio, practising as a band, writing a song... anything is possible! All we ask of you is to come with a can-do attitude and if possible, bring your own instrument(s) plus any backing tracks you may wish to use when recording in a studio. <b>This activity is for GCSE Music students only.</b>	<b>£0</b>
<b>Option 8 Change the World with your Voice Workshop</b>	See timetable for time <b>Meet in C4.04 24 Places Available</b>	Students will assume the role of national ambassadors or representatives of the United Nations to debate and seek to solve global issues. There are few better ways of understanding international affairs and global politics than putting yourself 'in the shoes of world leaders'. You will research and discuss UN topics and represent an adopted country's position, allowing you to argue from an unfamiliar perspective, develop knowledge, understanding and empathy.	<b>£0</b>
<b>Option 9 English Creative Workshop</b>	See timetable for time <b>Meet in R0.02</b>	A day of activities based around creative writing! We will play around with different types of poetry - using song lyrics, newspapers and books to create our own poetry. We will use art and media to inspire our own descriptive writing. By the end of the day, you will have started to create an anthology of your own creative writing.	<b>£0</b>
<b>Option 10 Football Workshop</b>	See timetable for time <b>Meet on the Top Field</b>	Students will have the opportunity to train in Football developing individual fitness, skills and game-play working with external coaches. Please ensure Football boots are worn for this workshop. Bring plenty to drink!	<b>£0</b>

<b>Option 12</b> <b>Year 9 Curriculum Timetable</b>	<b>9.10am – 3.05pm</b> Separate timetable to be issued once sign up is complete	All students will follow their curriculum timetable as planned for a Friday. Individual students may not be taught by their normal teacher, but a curriculum provision will be provided for each block. Students have chosen this option as they do not wish to take part in or watch the Sports Day or take part in an Enrichment Activity Option. Students will be informed of specific rooms they must attend for each block once the sign up has been completed. Mrs Reddy will meet all students who have chosen this option and inform them of their timetable and rooms. Students must wear College uniform or PE Kit.	<b>£0</b>





## Confirmation of student requirements

### All students must:

1. Wear their lanyards into College. They are compulsory.
2. Wear Ivybridge Community College blue PE kit and trainers (white socks) for the day.
3. Register with Tutors for the morning registration and then go directly to the room or venue stated in the timetable at 9.10am or 2.10pm.
4. Bring plenty of drinks (and snacks, if needed).
5. Attend break and lunch times, as normal.
6. Select an Enrichment Activity option using Microsoft Forms and remain in that activity on the Enrichment Day

**Please note** that any student, from now until Enrichment Week, who does not comply with College standards and expectations will be considered for removal from their Enrichment Activity. Parents/carers will be contacted if this action is required.

A register will be produced for each Enrichment Activity. Students will not be allowed to swap activities on the day. They must remain in their chosen activity.
