Enrichment Week 2022 - Early Sign-Up Packages

Ivybridge Community College will once again be hosting its very own Enrichment Week for Years 7 to 10 for 2022, however, it will be a descaled week in comparison to previous years due to the impact and restrictions of COVID-19.

What is Enrichment Week?

While a large proportion of Ivybridge Community College students' time is spent on ensuring their academic success, we also believe in helping students develop their characters; find out more about their interests and passions; and invest in their social, moral and cultural life skills.

The activities offered in Enrichment Week help improve our students' future employability, boost self-confidence, develop leadership skills, instil self-motivation, overcome fears and help them succeed in society. They are also a fantastic way to increase students' enjoyment of College life, creating an inclusive spirit and helping build life-long memories and friendships.

What happens?

During Enrichment Week the normal College timetable is collapsed and students are offered a range of alternative learning experiences and activities outside of the usual curriculum. The week provides students with the opportunity to see and experience places and attractions both in the UK and abroad.

When is it?

What is Enrichment Week Booklet 1 - Early Sign-Up Packages?

This booklet details those packages that require students to sign up a long time in advance of Enrichment Week. We are deliberately releasing this information and choice of packages as early as possible so that you have time to pay in instalments for the more expensive trips. Our aim is to provide a realistic, challenging and enriched selection of activities that fully engage your child.

The Early Sign-Up Booklet comprises eleven packages, either abroad or UK-based, which have been organised for our current Years 8 and 9 for 2022. Only three of the packages enclosed are residential.

Enrichment Week Timetable

Please find below the packages available to all students in Years 8 and 9 for Enrichment Week 2022. Please note some packages are also available for Year 10 and Year 12 due to a crossover with Work Experience.

Package 1 – The Somme Battlefields, France Trip This is a fantastic opportunity for students to visit the 1914 - 1918 Battlefields of the Somme, located in the beautiful, rural landscape of the region of Picardy and the Département de la Somme, France. This package includes visit to the Battlefields of the First World War for Year 8 and 9 students who have an interest in History. This is a residential week of five days and four nights. The visit will provide an opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of people's experiences of war and the impact it has on the life of the individual and the life of the nation. The visit will have as its main focus the Somme and will include many sites such as Newfoundland Park Memorial, Thiepval Memorial, Rancourt French War Cemetery, Devonshire Cemetery, Somme 1916 Museum, Wellington Quarry, Vimy Ridge, Historical de la Grande Guerre, Peronne, and to complete the week a day at the Parc Asterix (fun theme park). Package 3 - Football Refereeing Course and Football Training with Devon FA

The College would like to provide students with the opportunity to attend a Football Association Referee Course that is taking place during Enrichment Week. This is a **non-residential** week. The FA Referees Course is designed for anyone aged 14 and over who wants to join the tens of thousands of referees who operate week in week out in local parks, throughout the English Football pyramid, up to those who officiate the FA Cup Final and on the international stage.

The course: FA Referee Course and Training with Devon FA

Times: 9.10am – 3.15pm (timetable will be given nearer to the course)

The FA Basic Referee Training Course provides the introduction to officiating in Football. The course will introduce the learner to the Laws of the Game and their application delivered through theory and practical elements, outlining the skills required to operate as a match official in grassroots Football.

Course aims and objectives

To provide the learners with an introduction to the principles of officiating, delivering five modules of training around the laws, application and practical delivery on the training ground and through officiating a minimum of six matches.

Course content

The course will introduce some key aspects in the following:

- Introduction to officiating
- Assessment of knowledge
- Misconduct report writing
- Fouls and misconducts
- Written examination
- Theory DVD

Football Referee Continued:

- Practical application of law
- Practical skills and attributes

Practical involvement

Candidates will be encouraged to participate practically to maximise their opportunities for learning. Students will also have the opportunity to train with Plymouth Argyle during the week for a full day of Football coaching. A timetable will be available for all students nearer to the week.

Requirements and sport attire

Students will need to wear sports attire for the duration of the week. There will be a mixture of classroom-based activities and practical work on the All Weather Pitch so both sets of footwear are advised (trainers and football boots). Please could you also make sure that you wear suitable clothing for variable weather conditions. Please ensure you bring plenty of drink, sun cream and snacks to keep you going through the day.

Payment Information

Booking and payment of a package must be made using ParentPay. If you have not used it before, please go to www.parentpay.com and log in to activate your account and use the user name and password sent to you by the College.

All packages have a maximum number of spaces and are offered on a 'first come first served' basis. All packages are different with regards to the number of available spaces. If a package is full, students must choose an alternative package.

Once booking is completed and deposits are paid, a student's place is automatically secured. Students' details will be extracted from SIMS for offsite visits to include parent/carer contact details, medical information, and allergies. Please ensure you inform the College of any changes in personal details. The act of booking and paying for your child's package on ParentPay represents consent for them to participate in that chosen package and activities.

By handing in the return slip you are confirming payment of your deposit, chosen package and informing the College of any personal information that has changed since September 2021. You are also confirming your agreement with all the guidelines set out in the booklet. We also need to know about swimming ability if attending water-based activities.
- 5. All Early Sign-Up Packages will go live on ParentPay from 9.30am onwards **Friday, 4 March 2022**.

Financial Assistance

Financial assistance is available for Pupil Premium students, with a maximum of **£50** for each eligible student. If you wish your child to participate in a package, a deposit must be made of the required amount to confirm a place on ParentPay. Once the deposit has been made, the College will contribute £50 towards the chosen package.

Please email Helen Reddy at <u>enrichmentweek@ivybridge.devon.sch.uk</u> to discuss the financial assistance. Deposits must be made for a package prior to receiving the financial support. The support will be made directly to ParentPay.

Free School Meals

If your son/daughter is in receipt of free school meals, these are still available during Enrichment Week for packages that are non-residential.

Cancellation of Ivybridge Community College Trips and Insurance

If an Ivybridge Community College trip is cancelled by the company that is organising it, this will result in a full refund for the student. However, if a student books their place and subsequently cannot attend, unless another student is found who can take their place, the student is still liable for the full cost of the event.
