## Year 7 Enrichment Week 2022

Ivybridge Community College will once again be hosting its very own Enrichment Week for Years 7 to 10 for 2022, however, it will be a descaled week in comparison to previous years due to the impact and continued restrictions of COVID-19.

### What is Enrichment Week?

While a large proportion of Ivybridge Community College students' time is spent on ensuring their academic success, we also believe in helping students develop their characters, find out more about their interests and passions, and invest in their social, moral and cultural life skills.

The activities offered in Enrichment Week help improve our students' future employability, boost self-confidence, develop leadership skills, instil self-motivation, overcome fears and help them succeed in society. They are also a fantastic way to increase students' enjoyment of College life, creating an inclusive spirit and helping build life-long memories and friendships.

### What happens?

During Enrichment Week the normal College timetable is collapsed and students are offered a range of alternative learning experiences and activities outside of the usual curriculum. The week provides students with the opportunity to see and experience places and attractions both in the UK and abroad.

### When is it?

Tuesday, 5 July to Friday, 8 July 2022

### 1. Overview of the Week

Students will receive an Enrichment Week Booklet, which includes the activities and workshops available to them. Each Year Group will follow a different timetable. The activities and workshops are either **on-site** or **off-site**.

**On-site** activities will take place at the College and within College hours. Some will involve a cost. Consent Forms are not required. Students can still access the College Dining Hall during break times.

**Off-site** activities and workshops take place outside of the College. All students will be required to bring a packed lunch and drinks. Students must prepare themselves for all weather conditions (additional clothing, waterproofs, sun cream, sun hats, and sun glasses).

All Year 7 students are required to **register in specific areas of the College each morning. This is outlined in the detailed timetable.**

### Payment Information and How to Sign Up

Booking and payment of the multi-activity week must be made using ParentPay. If you have not used it before, please go to [www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com) and log in to activate your account and use the user name and password sent to you by the College.

Once booking is completed and payments have been made, a student's place is automatically secured. Students' details will be extracted from SIMS for off-site visits to include parent/carer contact details, medical information, and allergies. Please ensure you inform the College of any changes in personal details. **The act of booking and paying for your child's package on ParentPay represents consent for them to participate in that chosen package and activities.**
