The Performing Arts Department has organised a five day enrichment opportunity including a two day Dance workshop within College to challenge you both physically and creatively followed by three fantastic days in London. This opportunity is available for Years 8 - 12 during the College Enrichment Week in 2022.

For the Dance workshops on Monday and Tuesday students will need to arrive at College at 8.45am and meet at the Gymnasium Changing Rooms. The two days will take place in the Gymnasium.

We will be meeting to leave for London from Ivybridge Community College Coach Park at 8.00am on Wednesday, 6 July and will return on Friday, 8 July by approximately 8.00pm. The students will be travelling by coach and will give updates should there be a change in return time due to traffic.

The two night residential will include tickets to two West End Shows - 'Wicked' and 'Matilda', followed by two workshops where students will learn a song and dance from each of the shows.

Also included in the trip will be a Thames River Cruise, giving students the opportunity to take in the sights and sounds of the capital city. There will also be some free time for further sightseeing and shopping.

On both Wednesday and Thursday evening, students will have a chance to refresh and refuel at the Hard Rock Café on Wednesday night and Pizza Express on Thursday – all included in the price.

Students will stay in Wembley International Hotel, used regularly for College trips, where breakfast will be included as part of the package. We will be using the same coach transport for the duration of the trip.

### Travel

We will travel by executive coach with two drivers and have local use of the coach within the drivers' hour's regulations.

### Accommodation

We will be staying in the Wembley International Hotel where a hot breakfast is included for each student on Thursday and Friday. The hotel is ideally positioned for us to visit the area's popular attractions.

London is the Performing Arts capital of the UK and students will be able to see lots of famous sights whilst we visit our planned bookings. Students will be able to have time to experience the shops and sights within our itinerary, so they can get lots of iconic pictures.

### Kit List

The students will not be required to wear College uniform during the trip. However, they will need to wear their Ivybridge Community College Dance/PE kit or black dance attire for practical Dance workshops. This list is merely a suggestion and is by no means extensive.

The students should have the following items:
