A chance to begin your PADI and SCUBA experience starts here – experience the local underwater environment like never before, experience the weightlessness and the tranquility of the marine world. This is a **non-residential** week. We will be taking the opportunity to take students through the PADI Scuba Diver qualification over the course of three days, including theory development, pool training and open water dives. All equipment will be provided and the students will have the option of furthering their qualifications to the full (Junior) PADI Open Water Diver, for an extra fee. **Please note that there are medical restrictions associated with SCUBA diving** (especially those around respiratory ailments – asthma etc.) and we would ask that any queries are raised sooner rather than later. Further to the three days there will be a day at Splashdown in Paignton and a day Coasteering with Reach Outdoors in Paignton. On Thursday students will have a quick stop at Goodrington Sands Beach for an ice cream before heading back to the College.

Travel

We will be travelling by minibus for the entire week. Students will be allowed to leave items on the minibus, however they must take all items home at the end of the day.

What is included in the price?

- Return travel by minibus
- Entry into all the attractions and activities
- Wet suit and all equipment for Coasteering and Scuba Diving

What to wear and bring?

Students:

- Are allowed to wear mufti for all activities throughout the week.
- Must wear clothing suitable for the activity they are taking part in.
- All students must have sensible and practical footwear for all the off-site activities.
- Must be prepared for all weather conditions (hat, sunglasses, sun cream, and waterproof jacket).
- Must be responsible for their own valuables and personal items.
- Bring additional money for all off-site trips if additional food items or souvenirs are required.
- Bring a towel and swimming attire if attending Scuba Diving, Coasteering and Splashdown Water Park
- Bring a bag for all wet clothing.
- Must bring a swim suit to wear underneath a wet suit, old trainers to get wet and wear in the water, old swim shorts to go over a wetsuit, towel and dry, warm clothes for Coasteering and Scuba Diving.
- Bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink in a bag for all off-site trips.
- Bring a sensible rucksack with a change of clothes if required.
- May leave items on the minibus if required.
