Overview

The Football Academy players can train and play like a professional football player in Holland. This is a **residential** week. Just a 40-minute drive from Amsterdam City, Stay Okay accommodation is the perfect place for our students in a relaxed, open accommodation setting. All players will participate in two coaching sessions with the College's coaching staff, and there will be two friendly fixtures per squad. In addition to the Football training and matches, students will visit a Theme Park for the day, compete in Ten Pin Bowling, tour Ajax's famous Johan Cruyff Arena and various other experiences such as a cruise along the Amsterdam River. Students will travel by coach and ferry to Holland. This package comes with full travel insurance with AXA Travelsure (this covers COVID-19 and a sports trip).

## Amsterdam

Amsterdam is the Netherlands' capital city, known for its artistic heritage, elaborate canal system and narrow houses with gabled facades, legacies of the city's 17th-century Golden Age. Its Museum District houses the Van Gogh Museum, works by Rembrandt and Vermeer at the Rijksmuseum, and modern art at the Stedelijk.

## Overview

#### Accommodation

We will be staying in the Hostel Heemskerk, a 13<sup>th</sup> Century Castle called Slot Assumburg. It features a large entrance, lavish halls, and a moat. There is also a sizeable garden to the back of the castle, allowing our footballers to adventure outside and have quiet time.

#### Insurance

Comprehensive travel insurance is provided by AXA TravelSure Insurance.

#### Passport and EHIC Information

All students must have a passport for this package. Please ensure all passports are in date with at least three months remaining on the date of return. Students must bring their own passport on Monday, 4 July 2022.

You must order a free UK Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC) or European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) before leaving the UK. If your child already has an EHIC it will still be valid as long as it remains in date. The GHIC or EHIC entitles you to state provided medical treatment that may become necessary during your trip. #### **COVID-19 Information and Entering the Netherlands**

As you are aware, entering a country is still complicated and restrictions are still in place. For students to enter the Netherlands they must fulfil the requirements of **either** option **1a or 1b**:

- 1. Have an NHS COVID-19 pass (on phone and paper copy) which shows that a student is either:
  - a. Double vaccinated, **or**
  - b. Has had a positive COVID-19 result in the last 11-180 days (six months)

In addition to travel requirements, all students will need to fill in a Passenger Locator Form (further details will be given nearer to the time to confirm what is needed).

- 1. EHIC or GHIC Card
- 2. Passport (to clearly show photo, dates and passport number)
- 3. COVID-19 Pass or COVID-19 Recovery Pass

### Money

Any money that the students wish to take with them for shopping and food etc. will be their responsibility throughout the trip. We would recommend students put some money aside at the start of the trip for the journey home on the Friday to ensure that they can buy food on the ferry etc. Students will be required to bring money for lunch and drinks every day. We will have a conversation with the students about the use of their money and try to encourage them to plan their spending throughout the trip

### **Personal Items**

Any personal items such as phones, watches, books, headphones etc. that the students wish to take with them on the trip, to occupy themselves. This will be their responsibility and the College cannot be held liable for any misplaced or broken items.

### Match Day Equipment

The College will take their match day First Aid Kits which will be fully stocked with spares for the fixtures that the students will play whilst we are away. The College will not provide personal items such as sock tape.

### Bags

We recommend that students take 2 bags with them. One large bag to go in the baggage area of the coach and another to take personal items that they want access to for the travel.
