# Kit List

- 3 Season boots with ankle support
- Walking trousers/shorts, quick drying (not Jeans)
- Wicking t-shirt (not cotton)
- Fleece
- Waterproof coat
- Waterproof trousers
- Warm hat/ Sun hat
- Gloves
- Water Bottle (min 1 Litre but do not carry more than 2 Litres of liquid)
- Food and water
- Head torch and spare batteries
- Full set of spare clothes
- Snacks and spare food
- Personal first aid kit and any medication needed
- Eating utensils and mess tin
- Sleeping bag
- Roll mat
- Multi day rucksack (651 approx.)
- Toiletries

# Extras

- Sun cream (high factor)
- Insect repellent
- Sunglasses
- Dry bags
- Rucksack liner

# Money

Money is not required. Duke of Edinburgh expeditions are self-sufficient so students need to carry all they need for the duration.
