Enrichment Week 2024

Ivybridge Community College will once again be hosting its Enrichment Week for Years 7 to 12 for 2024.

While a large proportion of Ivybridge Community College students' time is spent on ensuring their academic success, we also believe in helping students develop their characters; find out more about their interests and passions; and invest in their social, moral and cultural life skills.

The activities offered in Enrichment Week help improve our students' future employability, boost self-confidence, develop leadership skills, instil self-motivation, overcome fears and help them succeed in society. They are also a fantastic way to increase students' enjoyment of College life, creating an inclusive spirit and helping build life-long memories and friendships.

What happens?

During Enrichment Week the normal College timetable is collapsed and students are offered a range of alternative learning experiences and activities outside of the usual curriculum (Enrichment Packages). The week provides students with the opportunity to see and experience places and attractions both in the United Kingdom and abroad.

When is it?

Monday, 8 July to Friday, 12 July 2024

Residential and non-residential

Students have the exciting opportunity to experience a wide variety of team building and outdoor adventurous activities. There are over 25 different packages for Year 8 and 9 students to choose from.

The activities offered during Enrichment Week are both **residential trips** (overnight) and **non-residential** (day trips). Students can select one package to attend for the week which will consist of five days of activities.

What is Enrichment Week Booklet 1?

This booklet details those packages that require students to sign up a long time in advance of Enrichment Week. We are deliberately releasing this information and choice of packages as early as possible so that you have time to pay in instalments for the more expensive trips. Our aim is to provide a realistic, challenging and enriched selection of activities that fully engage your child.

Booklet 1 comprises eight packages, either abroad or UK-based, which have been organised for our current Year 8 and 9 students for 2024. All eight of the packages enclosed are **residential**.

How to sign up to a package

Please find below eight residential Enrichment Week packages available for our Year 8 and 9 students. In order to confirm these packages with our suppliers, it is important that we have a clear idea of how many students would like to subscribe to each package. We therefore kindly ask that you **sign up** to show your child's interest in going on a trip during Enrichment Week. Please complete the Sign-up Form <u>here</u> by no later than **Friday**, **22 March 2024**:

Students will be given three options:

- 1. First choice package
- 2. Second choice package
- 3. Wait for Booklet 2, which has non-residential Enrichment Week packages

Once you have completed the form, if the residential package has the required interest/numbers to make it viable, you will be emailed with confirmation of this and the trip details will be made available to you on ParentPay to make payment and secure the package.

The sign up to the Booklet 1 packages will close on Friday, 22 March at 11.00am.

ParentPay will be made available on Tuesday, 26 March to those who have been confirmed a place on the trip only. The deadline for deposits to be paid is Thursday, 28 March by 11.00am.

Oversubscribed Packages

In the event that a package is oversubscribed, we will choose participants by random selection to ensure the process is fair for all students. If a student is not successful, we will endeavour to offer them their second choice and if this is not possible, we will contact you directly.

Package A The Somme Battlefields,	This is a fantastic opportunity for students to visit the 1914 - 1918 Battlefields of the Somme, located in the beautiful rural landscape of Picardy and the Département de la Somme, France. This package includes visits to the Battlefields of the First World War for Year 8 and 9 students who have an interest in World War One and History. The visit will provide an opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of people's experiences of war and the impact it has on the life of the individual and the life of the nation. The visit will have its main focus as the Somme and will include many sites such as Newfoundland Park Memorial, Thiepval Memorial, Rancourt French War Cemetery, Devonshire Cemetery, Somme 1916 Museum, Wellington Quarry, Vimy Ridge, Historical de la Grande Guerre and to complete the week a day at Parc Asterix (a fun theme park). Payment Information

There are plenty of opportunities for all students to sign up to something exciting to take part in.

The Sign-Up Form to the Booklet 1 packages will close on Friday, 22 March at 11.00am.

ParentPay will be made available on Tuesday, 26 March to those who have been confirmed a place on the trip only. The deadline for deposits to be paid is Thursday, 28 March by 11.00am.

You will be required to pay the **deposit** for the chosen package in order to secure your child's place on the trip. **Students will not be able to move to another package once a deposit has been made.**

All packages have a maximum number of spaces. All packages are different with regard to the number of available spaces.

Once booking is completed and deposits are paid, a student's place is automatically secured. Students' details will be extracted from SIMS for off-site visits to include parent/carer contact details, medical information, and allergies. Please ensure you inform the College of any changes in personal details. The act of booking and paying for your child's package on ParentPay represents consent for them to participate in that chosen package and activities.

ParentPay Support

If you have not used ParentPay before, please go to <u>www.parentpay.com</u> and log in to activate your account using the username and password sent to you by the College.

Financial Assistance

There is financial assistance for the following students:

- Students in receipt of Free School Meals 50% contribution towards the package of choice (up to a maximum contribution of £500) or up to £50 contribution if the package is £100 or less
- **Pupil Premium students** (excluding Service Pupil Premium) will receive a £50 contribution towards the cost of the activity of their choice.

If you wish your child to participate on a trip package, a deposit must be made of the required amount to confirm a place on ParentPay. Once the deposit has been made, the College will contribute the relevant financial assistance towards the chosen package automatically on ParentPay.

Free School Meals

If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, these are still available during Enrichment Week for packages that are non-residential.

Cancellation of Ivybridge Community College Trips and Insurance

If an Ivybridge Community College trip is cancelled by the company that is organising it, this will result in a full refund for the student. However, if a student books their place and subsequently cannot or does not wish to attend, unless another student is found who can take their place, the student is still liable for the full cost of the event.

Once a deposit is received, this is taken as confirmation that the parent/carer is committed to paying the full cost of the trip. After **Friday**, **5** April **2024**, if a student decides not to attend the trip and their place is taken by another student, deposits are non-refundable.

If there is an exceptional circumstance, such as illness or injury resulting in a student being unable to attend the trip, a suitable doctor's note will be required in order to proceed with an insurance claim.

What's next?

A second booklet will be sent to parents/carers confirming the chosen package. The second booklet will contain detailed information regarding final costs, times, kit lists and logistics.
