What happens?

The chance to begin your PADI and SCUBA experience starts here – experience the local underwater environment like never before, experience the weightlessness and the tranquility of the marine world. We will take students through pool training and open water dives. All equipment will be provided and the students will have the option of furthering their qualifications to the full (Junior) PADI Open Water Diver, for an extra fee at a later date. Students also have the opportunity to take part in snorkeling and rock pool safaris.

Please note that there are medical restrictions associated with SCUBA diving (especially those around respiratory ailments – asthma etc.) and we would ask that any queries are raised sooner rather than later. Further to these three days, there will be a day at Splashdown in Paignton and a day coasteering.

Students have the opportunity to take part in an active week of training and developing their Rugby skills! The week includes participating in training camps and playing Touch Rugby. Coaches will customise activities to suit individual players, focusing on enhancing Rugby-specific skills, goal-setting, decision-making and leadership abilities. Each day will feature a well-organised agenda of Rugby drills, with players benefiting from interaction with multiple coaches. While the emphasis remains on enjoyment and fostering camaraderie, participants will also have ample opportunity to refine various kicking techniques, from goal-kicking to cross-fields, positional specific skills and conditioned game play in a safe and supervised setting offered by the camps.

After two days of Rugby, students can then participate in four hours of mountain biking at Haldon Forest, with qualified instructors leading the students. The centre will provide mountain bikes and equipment; however, students may want to bring their own helmets and protective equipment. Personal bikes will not be allowed on the coach. Students will also spend a day at the Plymouth Life Centre taking part in diving and climbing classes. Students will finish off the week with a day at Splashdown, no doubt racing each other down the water slides!

Students will visit Longleat Safari Park, Crealy Adventure Park, Paignton Zoo, Plymouth Aquarium and Dartmoor Zoo. Students will also have the opportunity to watch a squid dissection at the Aquarium and complete a climate change challenge at Dartmoor Zoo. This week is especially for students who love animals, birds, insects and coastal walks. Students will get the chance to watch them and learn about them. Students will spend their five days visiting an RSPB Reserve in Powderham, Exminster, design bug and bird boxes, visit the Aquarium and have ice cream on the Barbican, as well as take part in a coastal walk and a scavenger hunt.

Just five miles from Exeter city centre, Exminster and Powderham Marshes are great places to see birds all year-round. Enjoy a lovely walk here in this fascinating landscape, where flocks of geese, ducks and waders are numerous. Regular visitors include lapwings, redshanks, wigeons and warblers. Students will have the opportunity to design and make bug and bird boxes, and take part in an ocean-based design activity. Did you know that an average garden could hold over 2,000 different species of insects! By providing the right habitats we can greatly increase the number of beneficial insects, such as bumblebees, whose numbers are rapidly declining in the wider countryside.

We will then spread our wings and visit Bristol, immersing ourselves in the maritime and industrial heritage at the M-Shed, Bristol docks amongst other locations. As well as this, we take some time to explore the hidden history in Exeter with a visit to the Royal Albert Memorial Museum before heading down to the quayside. Students will then be taken back to Roman Britain with a visit to Bath and the famous Roman Baths, and later the UNESCO world heritage site of Stonehenge. Package 3 – Football Refereeing Course and Football Training with Devon FA

The College would like to provide students with the opportunity to attend a Football Association Referee Course that is taking place during Enrichment Week. This is a **non-residential** week. The FA Referees Course is designed for anyone aged 14 and over who would like to join the tens of thousands of referees who operate week in week out in local parks, throughout the English Football pyramid, up to those who officiate the FA Cup Final and on the international stage.

The course: FA Referee Course and Training with Devon FA

Times: 9.10am – 3.15pm (timetable will be given nearer to the course)

The FA Basic Referee Training Course provides an introduction to officiating in Football. The course will introduce the learner to the laws of the game and their application delivered through theory and practical elements, outlining the skills required to operate as a Match Official in grassroots football.

Course aims and objectives

To provide the learners with an introduction to the principles of officiating, delivering five modules of training around the laws of the game, application and practical delivery on the training ground, and through officiating a minimum of six matches.

Course content

The course will introduce some key aspects in the following:

- Introduction to officiating
- Assessment of knowledge
- Misconduct report writing
- Fouls and misconducts
- Written examination
- Theory DVD

Football Referee Course Content:

- Practical - application of law
- Practical - skills and attributes

Practical involvement

Students will be encouraged to participate practically to maximise their opportunities for learning. They will also have the opportunity to train with Plymouth Argyle during the week for a full day of football coaching. A timetable will be available for all students nearer to Enrichment Week.

Requirements and sports attire

Booking and Payment Information

All students are invited to select one package for Enrichment Week. There are plenty of opportunities for all students to sign up to something exciting to take part in.

The sign-up for an Enrichment Package for **Years 8 and 9** will be via ParentPay only. You will be required to pay the **deposit** for the chosen package in order to secure your child's place on the trip. **Students will not be able to move to another package once a deposit has been made.**

All packages have a maximum number of spaces and are offered on a 'first come first served' basis. All packages are different with regard to the number of available spaces. If a package is full, students must choose an alternative package.

All packages will **go live** on ParentPay on **Tuesday, 7 May 2024** from **8.30am**.

Please note that due to restrictions with the ParentPay set up and system, it is not possible to release the activities and packages in the evening or overnight. Please also note that each package will be released in letter order, therefore it can take up to 20 minutes to complete the process.

Once booking is completed and deposits are paid, a student's place is automatically secured. Students' details will be extracted from SIMS for off-site visits to include parent/carer contact details, medical information, and allergies. Please ensure you inform the College of any changes in personal details. **The act of booking and paying for your child's package on ParentPay represents consent for them to participate in that chosen package and activities.**

Financial Assistance

There is financial assistance for the following students:

- **Students in receipt of Free School Meals** – 50% contribution towards the package of choice (up to £500) or up to £50 contribution if the package is £50 or less
- **Pupil Premium students** (excluding Service Pupil Premium) will receive a £50 contribution towards the cost of the activity of their choice.

If you wish for your child to participate on a course or trip package, a deposit must be made of the required amount to confirm a place on ParentPay. **Once the deposit has been made, the College will contribute the relevant financial assistance towards the chosen package automatically on ParentPay. Please do not email requesting financial assistance.**

Free School Meals

If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, these are still available during Enrichment Week for packages that are non-residential.

Cancellation of Ivybridge Community College Trips and Insurance

If an Ivybridge Community College trip is cancelled by the company that is organising it, this will result in a full refund for the student. However, if a student books their place and subsequently cannot or does not wish to attend, unless another student is found who can take their place, the student is still liable for the full cost of the event.

Once a deposit is received, this is taken as confirmation that the parent/carer is committed to paying the full cost of the trip. After **Wednesday, 15 May 2024**, if a student decides not to attend the trip and their place is taken by another student, deposits are non-refundable.

If there is an exceptional circumstance, such as illness or injury resulting in a student being unable to attend the trip, a suitable doctor's note will be required in order to proceed with an insurance claim.
