- Future Musicians is our orchestral music programme for primary school students in Years 4, 5 and 6.
- It costs just £84.00 (plus booking fee) per year (free for those eligible for Free School Meals). You can pay the whole amount or in two instalments.
- Students choose to receive tuition in a group in one of the following instruments: Violin, Viola, Double Bass, Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Tuba and Percussion.
- A free musicianship session is included where all students will learn to read music notation and learn to play the keyboard.
- A free loan instrument can be used at the sessions.
- Gain your Arts Award Discover qualification through the programme.
- Progression available to our **free** Junior Orchestra.

- 4.30 to 5.30pm for Years 3 to 6


#### **Primary Dance**
