Where to meet for the enrichment sessions?

All students are to meet at the venue stated on the timetable, for the time allocated and for the specific enrichment activity. The teacher in charge of each enrichment activity will meet and greet all students on arrival to the sessions and provide instructions for where to place bags and personal property.

Student Registration

There is no need for any students to sign up for the enrichment sessions, unless stated otherwise. Simply, turn up to the venue as stated on the timetable and your name will be recorded each time you participate.

Elite Squads and Registration

All Elite Squads are required to participate in training sessions as stated on the Enrichment Programme. All Elite Squad members have been automatically placed on to SIMS for registration for after-College enrichment. All Elite Squads are to meet at the venue stated on the timetable at the start of every session.

What to wear and bring?
